What is autism?

A variable developmental disorder that appears by age three and is characterized especially by difficulties in forming and maintaining social relationships, by impairment of the ability to communicate verbally or nonverbally, and by repetitive behavior patterns and restrictive interests and activities. (merriam-webster.com)

Autism vary from Mild, Moderate, Severe

Mild Autism - a person may require minimal or no support in day to day living skills.

Moderate Autism - a person may need support, may be non verbal or limited speaking. The person may have noticeable behavior concerns, repetitive habits and echolalia (echoing the words of another person).

Severe Autism - a person may not speak at all or have noticeable regression. The person may need much support from the caregiver.
